Grand Lodge Education Committee

An important part of the Minnesota Masonic Education Program is the Grand Lodge of Minnesota Masonic Book Club. This program is designed to encourage good Masonic reading by our Brethren and to give them new and interesting books by Masonic authors. It was started as a service to Masons, providing good Masonic books at affordable prices.

Here is how the Club works—you sign up by providing your name, address, telephone number, and promise to fulfill the obligations of club membership. There is no registration fee!

Four times each year, you will receive a book selection with an accompanying invoice through the mail. If you wish to keep the book, pay the invoice by return mail, or within 30 days. If you do not wish to keep the book, simply return it to the Grand Lodge Bookstore within 30 days. If you have kept the last book but have not paid for it, you might not receive the next book; you may receive a mailing explaining what the next book is and why you are not receiving it or you may receive the next book with a reminder notice to pay for both of the books now due.

Every effort will be made not to duplicate book selections offered through other Masonic book clubs or societies. All books will be invoiced for a reasonable price, arrived at by adding the actual cost of the book, plus tax and postage. Most book selections will be around \$25 or less and will probably still be less than the book's cover price.

When joining the Minnesota Masonic Book Club you agree to pay for the title received plus the postage or return the book, within 30 days of receipt of the new selection. If you don't pay for an issue you simply will not receive the next selection.
