PROSPECT QUESTIONS BEFORE INTERVIEW

The following questions are serious items for you to consider for the interview process.

Do you understand that you will be committing yourself to participating in the life of the Lodge and all its business aspects as well as its mission of bringing light (knowledge) to its members?

In what ways do you think you will be an asset to the Lodge?

Do you understand that one aspect of Masonry is self-improvement and real inner initiation, coming to grips with the big questions: Where did I come from? What am I? Where am I going?

Do you understand that the practice of charity is a part in this search for self-improvement and that it may ask you to make either financial donations or contributions of your time as a volunteer working within the Lodge and for other charitable causes taken up by the Lodge?

Do you understand that participation in your Masonic Lodge should be a principal duty? Further Degrees in the York Rite, Scottish Rite, or in the Shrine should not detract from your commitment to our Lodge.

Why do you want to join a Lodge of Freemasonry?
